



First Annual Nevada State BBQ Championship to be decided in Mesquite

Some folks just know a good thing when we see it...or taste it!

With the success of the 6th annual Best Dam Barbeque Challenge in Boulder, Nv., and the smokin' success of last year's inaugural Smokin in Mesquite BBQ Championship, it made perfect sense to combine flavors and create the first ever Nevada State BBQ Championship.

That's just what the event directors from the Mesquite Resort Association (host of Smokin in Mesquite) and the Boulder City Rotary Club (host of Best Dam Barbeque Challenge in Boulder City) decided to do.

The two events, (Boulder event was held Memorial Day weekend, May 28-29, while the Mesquite event set for Labor Day weekend, Sept. 3-4) are the largest and most popular BBQ events in the state. Combining competitions point totals from the two events will award the winning team the first ever Nevada State BBQ Championship.

The agreement between the two events calls for the barbeque team with the most combined points being crowned the champion and awarded a check for \$3,000 this year. All eligible teams from across the nation must compete in both events to be in the running for the Nevada crown.

The Boulder City event, now in its 6th year, has grown in popularity and purse. This year the Best Dam BBQ Challenge awarded \$10,000 in prize money.

"We have done very well," said Chris Carroll of the Best Dam Barbeque Challenge. "We were up to about 40 entries and I'll bet we drew 20,000 enthusiasts in 2010. We draw from Boulder City, Las Vegas and Henderson, Nv. and the event is now on the calendars of many in Southern Nevada each year."

Carroll said the Boulder City event is a fund raiser for the Boulder City Rotary Club, while also helping programs which help bring awareness to youth drinking and drugs. The 2010 event received a big boost when it was announced that Verizon had jumped on board to sponsor the family fun zone. This year's event also included a rib eating contest between the Boulder City police and fire departments.

Now in its second year the Smokin' in Mesquite event will offer an estimated \$40,000 in cash and prizes. Both events are sanctioned by the Kansas City Barbeque Society, one of the premier competition organizations in the country (13,000 members) and use KCBS certified judges.

The Smokin' in Mesquite event and its KCBS sanction was spear-headed by Black Gaming Director of Food Operations, Bruce Landvik and group sales executive Darrell Edwards. With the assistance of Black Gaming Sporting Events Manager, Christian Adderson, the event enjoyed a tremendous first year with huge crowds and was featured the TLC Network's BBQ Pitmasters show.





"This is an incredible event," says Edwards. "The sky is the limit how far this event can go. Mesquite is the perfect locale for such a gathering considering the top quality hotel amenities we have here. Adding the possibility of being crowned Nevada State BBQ Champion will help us reach the next level."


Adderson says the partnership between the two events will enable both events to grow.

"I visualize competitors planning to be at both events every year,"
Adderson said. "They are healthy, fun promotions, both of which

Golf Courses in Mesquite, Nevada and St. George, Utah

CasaBlanca Golf Club 18 Holes • Par 72 • 7,011 Yards Architect – Cal Olson Director of Golf – Dan Griffin

CasaBlanca is a desert course with 13 of the 18 holes having water on them which provides a challenge to golfers and a habitable wetland for the desert fowl. The Cal Olson designed course meanders naturally through and around the Virgin River and is accommodating to golfers of all skill levels, with its modestly sloping mounds and fairways and five sets of tee markers. The signature hole at CasaBlanca is number 17, which is a lengthy par-four requiring a precise tee shot and an equally accurate longiron second to a green which narrows in the front. Parshooters won't stop smiling all the way to the 18th tee.

Falcon Ridge Golf Club 18 Holes • Par 71 • 6,650 Yards Architect – Kelby Hughes Director of Golf – Brian Wursten

The Falcon Ridge Golf Club is woven through the hills and valleys giving one a feeling of a high desert golf course. The pine trees along with the sculpted fairways add to southwest flavor. Playability is at a premium at Falcon Ridge, having multiple tee boxes it will meet the need of every golfer. The course is set up to give everyone a blend of pure simplicity, spectacular views and demanding holes.

The Palmer Course at the Oasis Golf Club 18 Holes • Par 72 • 6,982 Yards Architect – Arnold Palmer Director of Golf – Randy Tickner

Golfers playing The Palmer Course at Oasis Golf Club won't be surprised to hear that this challenging and scenic wonder was created by Arnold Palmer. And the best advice is vintage Arnie: hitch up your trousers—or skirt—and go for it. The Palmer Course at Oasis Golf Club has several elevated tee boxes with dramatic shots to slot canyon fairways that meander through the foothills surrounding northern Mesquite. The narrow fairways are accented with many bunkers, water hazards, and undulations that leave the golfer with few level lies. But nothing looks or feels artificial here as Palmer used the natural landscape to provide all the drama. The 363-yard sixth hole is representative: the green is set deep within a box canyon that looms over all approach shots. And only the brave need venture to the back tee at the 517-yard eighth hole, which requires a 250-yard drive to clear rugged country.


The Canyons Course at the Oasis Golf Club

18 Holes • Par 71 • 6,408 yards Architect - David Druzisky Director of Golf – Randy Tickner

The recently completed Canyons course at the Oasis Golf Club offers dramatic scenery while requiring well placed golf shots. Like the Palmer Course, the Canyons is blessed with a dramatic changed in elevation throughout, but the perfectly manicured Bermuda fairways are somewhat wider and more user friendly. Golfers will encounter plenty of water hazards on their tour of the Par 71 layout that takes wonderful advantage of its setting. Golfers will especially enjoy the unique par three finishing hole.

Palms Golf Club 18 Holes • Par 72 • 6,514 yards Architect – William Hull Director of Golf – Dan Griffin

The Palms was the first course built in Mesquite and gets credit for igniting the fuse that created the golf explosion here. Set amidst a desert landscape of sagebrush and tumbleweeds the course offers an island of palm trees and lush green fairways with a number of daunting water hazards. The Palms provides golfers with two contrasting nines: the front nine has fairly flat wide fairways with small lakes providing a precision challenge. The back nine takes full advantage of dramatic elevation changes offering incredible vistas, but the serendipity must be occasionally interrupted by forced carries over unforgiving canyons. Most memorable is the 536-yard 15th hole, a par-five that presents a 114-foot drop to the fairway below.



Golf Courses in Mesquite, Nevada and St. George, Utah

Conestoga Golf Club 18 Holes • Par 72 • 7,232 yards Architect - Gary Panks Director of Golf - Ray Metz

Conestoga Golf Club recently opened its Gary Panks-designed course that features a spectacular layout meandering through natural arroyos and dramatic elevation changes.

The design of the golf course utilizes native desert and natural washes creating a challenging layout with breathtaking canyon vistas.

Coral Canyon Golf Club (Utah) 18 Holes • Par 72 • 7,029 yards

Architect - Keith Foster Director of Golf - Gary White

Coral Canyon features 100 acres of manicured fairways, 55 bunkers, two lages and a labyrinth of dry washes through the course, offering players a variety of risk/reward opportunities that are critical to an exceptional golf experience. The golf course offers a rare opportunity for players to enjoy luxurious golf on the doorstep to some of the world's most famed natural wonders. Fairways are generously spacious and most holes allow the less accomplished player to run the ball onto the ultra smooth greens.

The Chase at Coyote Springs (Nevada) 18 holes • Par 72 • 7,471 Yards

Architect - Jack Nicklaus Director of Golf - Mike Sizemore

Jack Nicklaus' Signature-designed course - The Chase - at PGA Golf Club is a challenging 7,471-yard layout and is the first golf course in a series of Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Courses that will flow throughout the Coyote Springs community. The Chase's lush rye-grass fairways are set against a dramatic desert backdrop, with mountain vistas in every direction.

Sand Hollow Resort (Utah) 18 holes • Par 72 • 7,300 Yards

Architect - John Fought Director of Golf - Mark Whetzel

The Championship Course at Sand Hollow is as visually stunning as it is challenging, moving in and around the world-renown distinctive red rock formations of southern Utah. The Championship Course features elevated tees, wide sweeping fairways and challenging greens. Golfing traditionalists will also love playing the Links Course at Sand Hollow. A throw back to the days of early golf, the Links Course is a stunning nod to the true walking golf experience and rich heritage of the game of golf.


